Subject : Humboldt Bay Fire Conducting Destructive Hands-On Training at 2921 E Street

Humboldt Bay Fire will be conducting destructive hands-on firefighter training at the old Norman's Dry Cleaning building at 2921 E Street over the next two weeks. This training will be confined to forcing doors and windows, cutting holes in the roof and walls to simulate forcible entry, ventilation and access techniques critical for firefighting operations. Security to the building will be maintained and training will not affect nearby structures. The entire building is slated to be demolished within the next few weeks by a certified contractor. NO live fire training will occur at this location. Training in buildings in the community provides invaluable knowledge and experience to our firefighters and helps them be better prepared for response to emergencies.

Humboldt Bay Fire greatly appreciates the support of the community in permitting us to train in structures other than our training site. Apparatus will be parked off-street in the building's parking lot and every effort will be taken to minimize our impact on the neighborhood.
