On 3/19/2022 @ 0720 hrs. Humboldt Bay Fire responded with 3 Engines, 1 Truck and 2 Chief Officers to a reported Residential Structure Fire in the 1300 block of McCullens Ave. The first Engine arrived within 3 minutes and found a single story residence with heavy smoke showing from the building. The first arriving engine initiated an interior attack and extinguished the fire within 15 minutes. Other HBF units ventilated the structure of smoke and searched the structure for any occupants. The residence was a vacant rental property that had just completed a remodel. There were no civilian or firefighter injuries and the residence suffered approximately \$100,000 in damage. HBF units remained on scene for 2 hours and after investigation the cause of the fire is accidental and electrical in nature.
