Humboldt Bay Fire realizes that many in our community felt unprepared for the Public Safety Power Shutoffs orchestrated by PG&E that affected our county this month.

Because of this, along with Humboldt Bay Fire Community Emergency Response Team (HBF CERT) and the American Red Cross, we will be holding an Emergency & Disaster Preparedness Presentation and Conversation this evening, October 24th at 5:30pm at our Rob Bode Training Classroom at 3030 L St. in Eureka, CA.

We were overwhelmed by the community response to this event, and have currently maxed out on our expected occupancy for *this* event. However, given the response, we are planning to hold additional events so that everyone who is interested in learning more about our local risks and how to prepare for them will have that opportunity.
