In light of the County's movement to the "Substantial" Red Tier / Tier 2, Humboldt Bay Fire is increasing precautions and adjusting operating procedures to further protect our personnel, patients, and community.

Effective immediately, Humboldt Bay Fire stations are closed to members of the public. Please call 707-441-4000 for any needed business, and continue to call 9-1-1 with emergencies requiring fire response and *alert the dispatcher to any flu-like symptoms*.

In an abundance of caution, we will also be temporarily suspending all non-essential contact with the public including hybrid CPR classes, smoke detector installations, fire extinguisher training, and other public education. If you need accommodation, have licensing requirements, or have concerns, please call us to make (virtual) arrangements.

Internal COVID precautions continue to protect our staff and our families.
